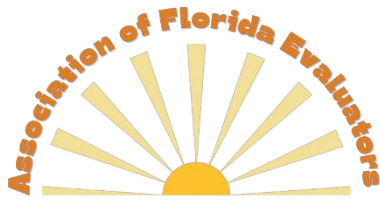

## 20\_\_\_\_ (year) Annual Florida Home Education Portfolio Review Evaluation

Per Florida law, a parent is to submit an annual evaluation to the school district superintendent once a year.

Per the FL DOE's Home Education FAQ, the anniversary of the Letter of Intent sets the evaluation deadline every year.

An evaluation is also due within 30 days of sending a Letter of Termination to end a home education program.

The parent of the above student is, according to Florida Statute FS 1002.41, hereby informing the Superintendent that this student has been evaluated by a Florida certified teacher holding a valid regular (professional) Florida certificate to teach academic subjects at the elementary or secondary level. This teacher, who was chosen by the parent, has conducted a review of the child's portfolio and has discussed this review with the pupil; the results are documented below.

Per Florida law, school districts may NOT add additional requirements beyond those in state law; this includes the use of specific forms. A variation of this form has been accepted throughout Florida since 2003.

Districts may NOT assign a grade level nor include an SSN or other additional personal information of a student in any official record unless the student chooses to participate in a school district program or state database.

Evaluation documentation is to be submitted by the parent and is typically sent to the Home Education Contact in the district.
